<b>8</b>	The student may travel in Moshi/Arusha unsupervised as part of a service activity trip, normally taking place afterschool or on weekends. Travel often will be in a school vehicle or approved taxi if it is beyond walking distance. The school will have contact information regarding the sponsor organization.		
<b>9</b>	The student may visit local shops or restaurants, approved by school, unsupervised on a weekend evening at the discretion of the residential staff. Trips will be a maximum of 4 hours, there must be at least 3 students and they must return by the designated time.		
<b>10</b>	The student may visit local shops or restaurants unsupervised that are approved by the school. They can only sign out twice between Monday and Thursday, with at least 3 students in a group. <b>(The school has its own shop, which supplies most of the students' needs).</b>		
<b>11</b>	The student may take part in trips arranged by people or organizations outside the school		
<b>12</b>	The student may stay overnight the house of a local student at the discretion of the school's administration.
